Project Description:

Combine a little lace netting, stamping, and glazes to make mom an elegant travel mug for those on-the-go days.

Project Time Span: 1 Hour

Skill Level: Basic

Instructions: Project instructions below. Mayco encourages you to vary colors, patterns and techniques to create your own designs.

1. Begin with properly fired shelf cone O4 [Bisque](#). Moisten a clean [Sponge](#) and wipe [Bisque](#) to remove any dust.
2. Place some FN-012 Lavender into a small cup and add a little bit of water to slightly dilute it. It should be the consistency of a coffee cream. Pour this into the Tumbler and roll around to completely coat the interior of the Tumbler. Drain out the excess [Glaze](#) and keep Tumbler inverted until it has lost its shine. Wipe off any [Glaze](#) from the outside using a damp [Sponge](#). Allow to dry.
3. Using a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan, apply 3 [Coats](#) of FN-012 Lavender to the outside of the Tumbler.
4. Cut a piece of netting type lace with small holes to fit a little larger than the tumbler, excluding the 1 1/2" band at the top of the tumbler.
5. Apply another coat of the FN-012 Lavender. Press the lace into the wet [Glaze](#) and smooth the lace to fit without any gaps in the lace.
6. Cut off any excess lace. Brush another coat of the FN-012 Lavender over the lace. Let semi-dry.
7. Using a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan, apply 2 [Coats](#) of SC-53 Purple Haze over the lace. Remove the lace when the second coat loses its shine.
8. Using the AC-213 [Sponge](#) on a Stick load the [Sponge](#) with SC-34 Down to Earth. Tap off excess color onto a paper towel and then tap onto the ST-366 Fruit Blossoms Stamp. Stamp the top band of the tumbler. Allow to dry.
9. Using a CB-106 # 6 Script Liner, stroke in the flower petals with SC-53 Purple Haze, the centers with SC-55 Yella Bout It, and the leaves with SC-9 Jaded. Allow to dry.
