Project Description:

Cheesecloth and paper combined with Foundations and Stroke & Coat make this springtime beauty.

Project Time Span: 1.5 hours

Skill Level: Basic

Instructions: Project instructions below. Mayco encourages you to vary colors, patterns and techniques to create your own designs.

1. Begin with properly fired shelf cone 04 [Bisque](#). Moisten a clean [Sponge](#) and wipe [Bisque](#) to remove any dust.
 2. Using a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan, apply 2-3 [Coats](#) of FN-001 White on the butterfly.
 3. Create and cut out a paper pattern of the white detail that is on the wings.
 4. Working with one wing at a time, brush wing with water. Place the paper cut-out in position, then finger press. Place a paper towel over the wing then press to remove excess water.
 5. Repeat for the other wing.
 6. Using a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan, apply 2 [Coats](#) of SC-42 Butter Me Up on the entire butterfly.
 7. Remove the paper after the last coat of SC-42 Butter Me Up has lost its shine.
 8. Cut a small piece of cheesecloth to fit about an inch larger than the body of the butterfly.
 9. Wet the cheesecloth and squeeze out any excess water.
 10. Lay the cheesecloth over the body then brush some thinned SC-42 Butter Me Up over the cheesecloth. This coat will prevent the cheesecloth from moving. Allow to dry to the damp stage.
 11. Using a CB-106 # 6 Script Liner, apply 1 coat of SC-14 Java Bean to the body. Pull off the cheesecloth as the SC-14 Java Bean loses its shine. Allow to dry
 12. Stilt and fire to shelf cone 06.
