Project Description:

Create a unique dragonfly by combining Elements, Jungle Gems and Stroke & Coat.

Designer: Marcia Roullard

Project Time Span: 1.5 hours

Skill Level: Basic

Instructions: Project instructions below. Mayco encourages you to vary colors, patterns and techniques to create your own designs.

1. Begin with properly fired shelf cone 04 [Bisque](#). Moisten a clean [Sponge](#) and wipe [Bisque](#) to remove any dust.
2. Using a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan, thin SC-32 Bluebeard and apply to the wings. When dry, wipe off excess with a damp [Sponge](#) to antique.
3. Using a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan, thin SC-5 Tiger Tail and apply sporadically to the wings. Thin SC-26 Green Thumb and SC-42 Butter Me Up and apply 2 sporadic [Coats](#) of each. Repeat until the wings are completely covered.
4. Using both a CB-106 # 6 Script Liner to go around the eyes and a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan for the body, apply 2 [Coats](#) of EL-118 Blue Grotto.
5. Using both a CB-106 # 6 Script Liner to go around the eyes and a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan for the body, apply 1 coat of CG-718 Blue Caprice to the body of the dragonfly, making sure the crystals are brushed on with the coat of [Glaze](#).
6. Apply 2 [Coats](#) of SC-15 Tuxedo to the eyes. Highlight the eyes with a stroke of SC-16 Cotton Tail.

7. Using a CB-110 # 10/0 Liner, outline the wings with SC-15 Tuxedo. Allow to dry.
 8. Stilt and fire to shelf cone O6.
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
