#### *Project Description:*

Create this eerie cup with Stroke & Coat and Foundations.

---

*Project Time Span:* 1 Hour

*Skill Level:* Basic

---

*Instructions:* Project instructions below. Mayco encourages you to vary colors, patterns and techniques to create your own designs.

---

1. Begin with properly fired shelf cone 04 [Bisque](#). Moisten a clean [Sponge](#) and wipe [Bisque](#) to remove any dust.
  2. Place some FN-009 Black into a small cup and add a little bit of water to slightly dilute it. It should be the consistency of a coffee cream. Pour this into the mug and roll around to completely coat the interior of the mug. Drain out the excess [Glaze](#) and keep mug inverted until it has lost its shine. Wipe off any [Glaze](#) from the outside using a damp [Sponge](#). Allow to dry. *Note:* Instead of rolling the [Glaze](#) inside the mug you could brush in 3 [Coats](#) of FN-009 Black.
  3. Using a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan, apply 1 coat of SC-11 Blue Yonder on the outside of the mug. With a damp [Sponge](#), wipe back leaving the color heavy in the crevices.
  4. Using a CB-604 # 4 Soft Fan, apply 2 [Coats](#) of FN-037 Chartreuse on the outside of the mug except for the teeth.
  5. Using a CB-106 # 6 Script Liner, apply 2 [Coats](#) of SC-16 Cotton Tail on the teeth.
  6. Using a CB-106 # 6 Script Liner, apply 1 coat of SC-15 Tuxedo on the eye and nose areas.
  7. Using a CB-106 # 6 Script Liner, apply 1 coat of Clear [Glaze](#) on the teeth. Allow to dry.
  8. Stilt and fire to shelf cone 06.
